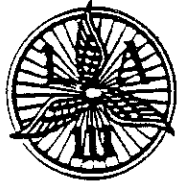




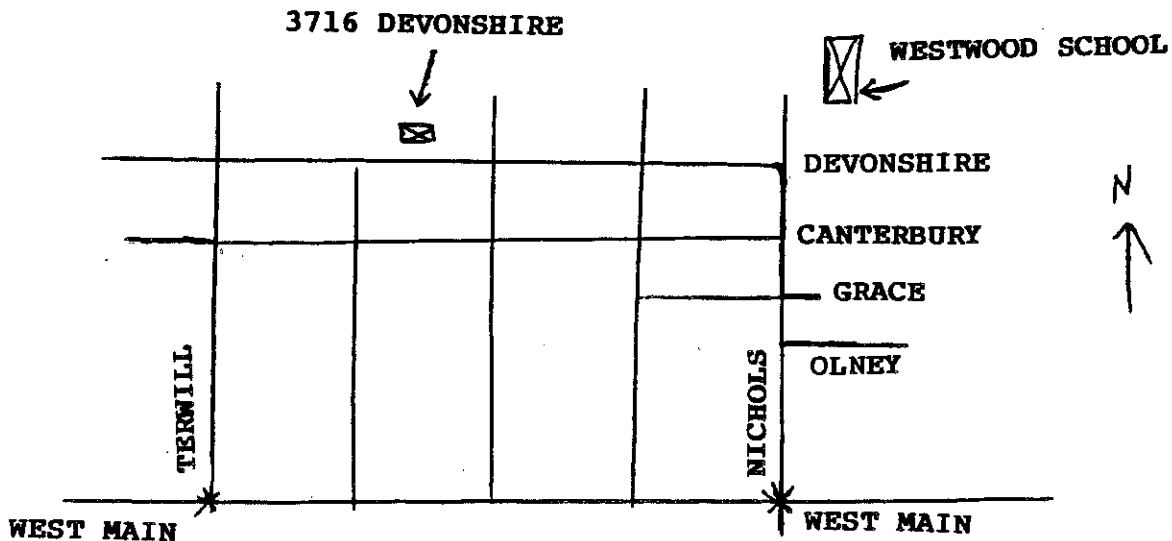

1986 AUGUSTA TIME TRIAL SERIES  
FINAL RESULTS  
KALAMAZOO BICYCLE CLUB

Overall, 130 different cyclists competed at least once on the 10 mile Augusta TT course. The best time was by a local rider, Dan Packman, at 21:41, and the only rider to break into the 21 minute range. Seven other men finished in the 22 minute bracket, including KBCers Tim Greening and me. The women's competition was won by Laura Charaneda, a college student temporarily in Battle Creek. Laura's times were the best recorded (23:58) for women in several years. The results for KBC members are summarized below.

Richard Boehme, a racing team member, entered twice and had a 23:37. Susan Bradford placed 10th in the overall women's competition with a 31:45. Kevin Brown tied for the most rides at 11 and posted a very quick 23:32. Tony Ettwein's best was 27:10. Bruce Evans recorded a 31:21 with one ride. Dan Ferrara, a long time racer, gets the Most Consistent award by crossing the line at 23:51 both times he entered. Ilse Gehbard was the 8th fastest women (1st among KBCers) at 30:11. Tim Greening, race captain for 1987, was 4th overall and the 2nd fastest KBC member (narrowly) at 22:19. Jeff Greiner rode 8 times and recorded a very fast 23:08, good for 9th overall and 3rd KBCer. Tim Hodges ended with a 27:30. Mickey Howell's best of 8 rides was a 24:23. The Kayser family was well represented: Cindy at 32:28, Eric at 23:53, and Tom at 24:38 (11th best KBC, and not bad for an older guy). Tom Lovett rode 10 times - his 23:29 was the 5th best KBC time. Mark McLain posted a 25:28 by himself; the McLain tandem lowered that to 24:17. Marty Minka, another USCF rider, had a best of 23:27. Frank Newton, famous citizen racer, checked in with a 26:02. Jeff Pregonzer rode to a 26:49. Doyle Rowland (tied for 1st with 11 TTs) rode consistently with a best of 28:31. Matt Rowland had a 34:27 in his first attempt this year. Ted Steinkamp finished with 25:29. Tom Yonker nearly broke into the 24 range with a 25:01. I finished with 22:18, which was the fastest KBC (3rd overall) time; however, I was most happy that for two years I have beat Tim Greening by one second.

Much thanks go to Sandy Kimbrough for organizing the timing AND the record keeping for the TT's -- we couldn't do it without you. And finally, I should probably apologize now for any mistakes or oversights; please let me know and I'll make the corrections.
