Sponsoring races makes us liable for any injuries or mishaps that might occur as our legal status now stands, therefore they are taking the appropriate steps to see that we are adequately protected.

There has been no change since the last report on the prospective use of the Spring Valley Park for the series of races tentatively scheduled for late April and early May. Jeff has contacted ABL of A for official sanction of the races.

The FEBRUARY MEETING will again be held at Kalamazoo College Library at 7:00 pm Feb 12 with refreshments served. The scheduled program features slides of the PawPaw race held in Sept, a demonstration on wheel building by Terry Florian of the Portage Pedal Shop, and riding on rollers. We may be able to get some short films of the East Lansing criterium and Rockford race for the March meeting.
