MINUTES OF THE KALAMAZOO BICYCLE CLUB MEETING OF OCTOBER 16, 1978

THE Meeting was called to order by Jini Caruso.  
TREASURER'S REPORT Phil Caruso reported that the net Club balance is approximately \$191 which should easily get us to the start of the new membership year which begins January 1st.

CANDIDATES FOR OFFICE FOR 1979 Jini announced that the Club needs volunteers for officers for 1979. At the November meeting we will vote on the offices of President, Vice-President and Secretary-Treasurer. The offices which will be filled by appointment by the Pres. are Road Captain, Racing Chair, Newsletter Editor, Librarian, Program Chair, Four Lakes, Distance Medley and Fall Century Chairs, and Race promoter. Jini asked for nominations and volunteers. Jan McLain volunteered for Treas but not Sec. Phil Caruso volunteered for sec-treas if no one else would. Phil also said he could be librarian. Dave Hageman and Sandy Kimbrough were nominated for Pres. Both are reluctant. Discussion revealed a consensus that the office of VP should be combined with Road Captain rather than Race Chair.

RACE PROGRAM FOR 1979 Joel ~~is~~ Dinda who is presently treasurer of the Racing Club had written a letter asking that the Club give him permission to proceed on a race program for the 1979 season. Joel's program, briefly outlined, involved a. two to four race dates for Spring Valley with some format changes, b. a criterium on city streets and c. the development of a new racing club ~~which~~ independent of KBC which would replace the present one by 1980. Joel indicated that he would underwrite the insurance for the racing series but that he would need permission from the club as well as about 8 volunteers to help stage the races. The dates suggested for the Spring Valley Series were : April 21, May 19, July 14 and August 11. Discussion revealed a concern about the ability of the Club to guarantee 8 people to work each of the race dates especially during the prime tourist time of July and August. Finally, there was a consensus that two dates such as those in April and May might be feasible with the possibility of substituting ~~August~~ the August date for that in either April or May.


It was agreed that Joel be granted permission to reserve dates as modified ~~and~~ and to continue planning, reporting back to the Club when plans are more complete. (NOTE: See schedule for race meeting below.)



FOUR LAKES Jini has talked with Portage Parks to see whether the new administration is ~~xxx~~ willing to work with us as the old one had and she~~x~~ reported that they are ~~xx~~ willing to do so as long as the origin of the ride is a Portage Park. Jini added that the ~~xxxxxxx~~ ride must also have access to bathrooms and food. ~~Sandy Kimbrough and Phil Raker~~ Shrier Park was one site mentioned. Sandy Kimbrough and Phil Raker agreed to check out some alternative locations.

MISCELLANEOUS At the end of the meeting, Phil Raker demonstrated some spiked bicycle tires he had constructed for winter ~~riding~~ riding and Sandy Kimbrough reported on her trip to Vermont. She took part in a tour staged by ~~xxxxx~~ Vermont Bicycle Touring and reported that she enjoyed her trip very much. (NOTE: Marv Miles took one of their tours ~~and~~ earlier this summer and also enjoyed his trip.
