Sunday July 16 1:00 from Parchment IGA 27 miles, a few hills, Al Holmes (349-3546)

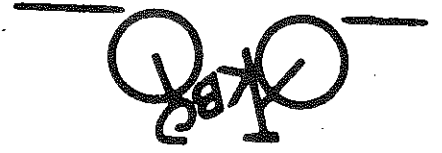
Saturday July 22 10:00 from Spring Valley Park to Richland, rolling hills, 20-25

small admission fee. Sandra Kimbrough (327-7690)

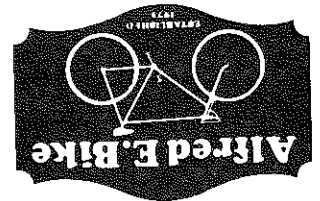
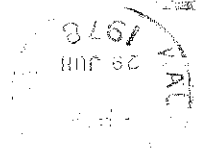
Sunday July 30 2:00 from Spring Valley Park to Gilmore Car Museum, slight hills,
