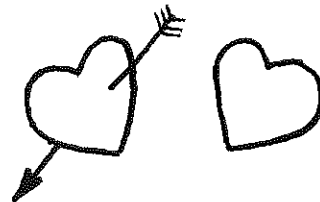

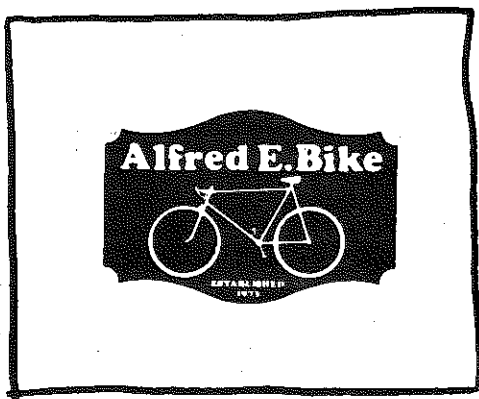
SUMMARY OF MINUTES OF KALAMAZOO BICYCLE CLUB MEETING, JANUARY 15, 1979

Treasurer reported a balance of \$245.77 including 21 renewals to date. The Racing Team report indicated that the Roller Race at the Kalamazoo Center was still tentatively set for February 10th. Spring Valley will be one race this year on April 21. The team hopes to present a criterium in June, and a cyclo-cross event in the fall. THE SKI EVENT SCHEDULED FOR JANUARY 27 WAS CANCELLED AFTER DISCUSSION. Cross Country Racing is scheduled for Turskiree that day and a number of KBC members are either racing or officiating. Races are both sanction and "citizen" type. Information is at some local bike shops. After brief discussion the club agreed to renew the bulk mail permit. We also agreed to again participate in the WHEELS FOR FAMILY FUN Program at Maple Hill Mall, this year scheduled for March 19th-24th. We then adjourned to ride rollers.
