







Minutes of the Kalamazoo Bicycle Club Meeting of February 18, 1979

WHEELS FOR FAMILY FUN Phil Caruso reminded those in attendance that the Club will have a booth at the Wheels For Family Fun display at Maple Hill Mall March 19 through 24th. Volunteers to staff the booth were requested and were received. Jini Caruso will be staffing the booth on Monday the 19th. the McLains volunteered for Tuesday, the Hageman's for Wednesday. Phil Caruso agreed to attend the booth on Thursday, Sandy Kimbrough on Friday, and Pat Florian on Saturday. Jini agreed to staff the booth on Sunday and dismantle the display. In addition to poitures of Club members in our various activities, there will be roller demonstrations by some of the members.

FOUR LAKES Sandy Kimbrough reported on progress in staging the annual Four Lakes ride which will take place Saturday May 5th at Schrier Park.
