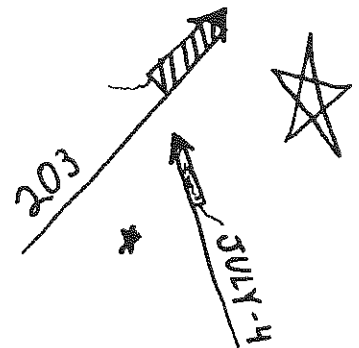

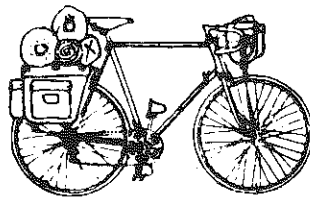
We then adjourned for wheel repair and tire changing demonstrations.
