

SCOTTS Mill TOUR

MAY 2, 1981



WHEN:

Saturday, May 2, 1981. Registration opens at 7:00 am and closes at 4:00 pm. Riding is from 7:30 am to 7:30 pm.

WHERE:

Toby Elementary School on 25th St., just south of the corner of 25th and QR Ave. Take I-94 to Sprinkle Road, south on Sprinkle about six miles, left onto S Ave. Turn left again at 26th St., then left onto RS Ave. RS takes a right 90° turn and becomes 25th St. Toby Elementary is about one mile on the left side of the road. (see map)

ROUTES:

Three routes, marked with Dan Henry arrows, will be available. A short 14 mile loop will go to Scott's Mill and back, through some beautiful farm and lake country. A 28 mile loop will meander over to Coldbrook Park, returning through the village of Climax and Scott's Mill Park. The 52 mile loop will follow the same route as the 28 miler, but will continue south from Scott's Mill on a long loop through the southeast corner of Kalamazoo County. A rider may bicycle any combination of these loops or any number of laps on one loop. Terrain will be basically flat with a few steep but short climbs.

COST:

\$3.50 for Kalamazoo Bicycle Club members, juniors under 14, seniors over 65, \$4.00 for all others. No late registration fee. Fee includes high energy snacks, lunch, "Scott's Mill Tour" patch and certificate, sag and repair service (does not include major parts), marked routes and map. Children under 13 must be accompanied by an adult. Those under 18 must submit signature of parent or guardian with entry/release form.

F00D:

Besides the snacks and lunch available at the starting point, there are grocery stores at Climax, Scotts, and Fulton Corners. There is also a fine restaurant in Climax.

PATCHES:

League of American Wheelmen sanctioned patches for the following distances will be available: century (25 miles), half century (50 miles), metric century (100 km or 62 miles), century (100 miles) and double metric century (125 miles). Cost is \$1.25 each.

SAG WAGON:

We will be patrolling the course periodically for breakdowns, both mechanically and physical! There will be a repair wagon at the starting point, but be prepared to make small repairs yourself, such as fixing a flat tire.

WEATHER:

Hopefully we will have a warm, calm day; however there will be no cancellation due to weather; we ride regardless!


