will be ordered if you want one.

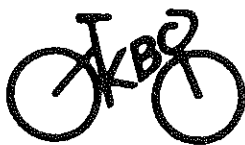

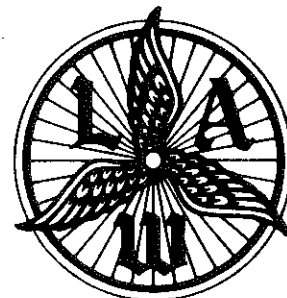

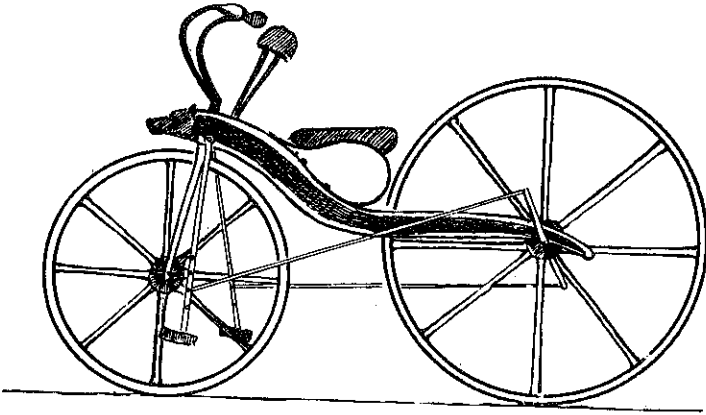
