The driver of the vehicle has been arraigned on manslaughter charges and the pretrial hearing, originally scenduled for August 19, has been postponed because the only witness, John Hart, is unavailable. At this writing Karin is still in critical condition at Borgess Hospital. John is at her side.

There is a Donna Ryskamp Memorial Fund being established which will pass on funds in Donna's name to either the U.S. Olympic Committee or to the Mothers (And Others) Against Drunk Driving. Some of the members had the privilege of knowing Donna and riding with her. We are greatly saddened by her death.


