**KARIN HART:** Karin Hart has now been moved to Mary Free Bed Hospital. Cards and letters may be sent to:

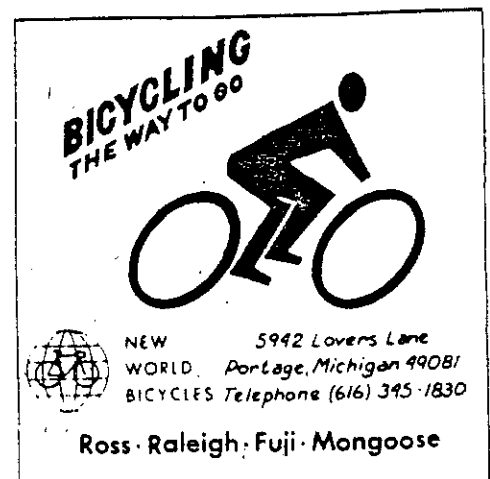
