**A BENEFIT RIDE**

On August 9, 1983 two KBC members were struck by a car while riding. Donna Ryskamp was killed. Karin Hart spent several months in a coma and is now undergoing rehabilitation in Mary Free Bed Hospital in Grand Rapids. In 1983 Karin and her husband John organized our Spring Ride. This year proceeds will go to help defray costs that insurance doesn't cover.

**RIDING** There will be loops of 4.4, 14, 31.5 or 53.5 miles. Choose the distance you are comfortable doing. The shorter two loops are flat, the longer two loops contain some hills and rolling sections. **WE WILL RIDE RAIN OR SHINE.**

**DONATION:** A donation of \$3.00 is suggested. More is welcome. All of the net proceeds will be given to Karin and John. We will sell **BIKE MONTH PATCHES** at our cost (\$1.50) for those who want a memento.

**SERVICES:** Maps of routes, route marked with arrows, mid-point rest stop with refreshments. We will be able to provide only limited on the road aid for repairs or riders unable to finish a loop.

**REGISTRATION** is open to anyone who wants to ride or make a contribution.

**TIME:** Registration will be open between 8 am and 3 pm. We recommend those starting after twelve plan on doing the either of the shorter two loops. The routes close at 6 PM. We will leave the midpoint rest stop at 5PM.

**HOW TO FIND THE RIDE:** Tobey School is located at 8551 East Long Lake Drive. Proceed south on Sprinkle Road until you reach Long Lake Drive. (It is about three-fourths of a mile past Ramona Park.) Turn left onto Long Lake Drive. At two oints the road will split. Choose the **LEFT** branch in each case to stay on Long Lake Drive. Tobey School is at the corner of Long Lake Drive and 25th Street.
