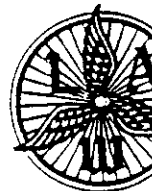

Ride Captain: responsible for obtaining volunteers to lead regular club rides.

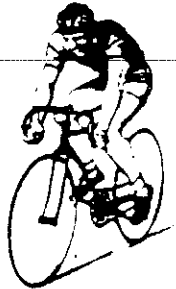
Race Captain: race promotions, keeping racers informed of coming events and USCF communications.
