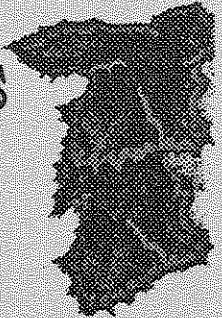


KBC Christmas at the Corner
