

Ride Our Routes 2021

What? Ride Our Routes 2021 (ROR21) is a Summertime FUN-RAISER that invites you to get outside on your bike and pedal through the cities, villages, and townships in and around Kalamazoo County. Together, individually and in small groups, we will traverse at least 1st Street to 48th Street and A Avenue to Z Avenue and many trails across our beautiful county. Use “More Info” QR Code on the left to learn more about ROR21.

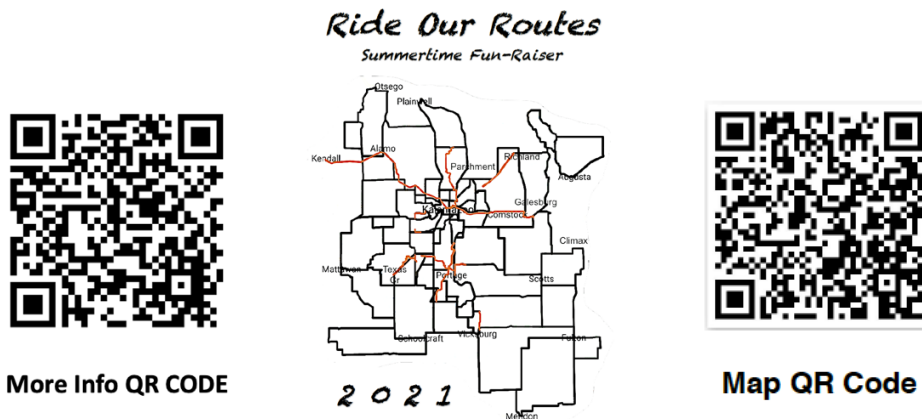
What’s more? You can get a t-shirt to commemorate your ROR21 accomplishment. How?

- Ride at least a representative sample of the approximately 500 miles of ROR21 routes shown on the map sometime during June-September 2021
- Record your rides on the backside of this form and submit it at one of our four local bike shops or Gazelle Sports. You will be eligible to purchase a t-shirt commemorating your ride.
- NOTE: Participants 15 years old and younger who successfully complete ROR21 and submit an entry form will earn a FREE t-shirt.

When? Summer (June-September) of 2021, hence the “Summertime Fun-Raiser” name.

Who? YOU, of course, and everyone else with a bicycle and a sense of adventure.

Where? The route map for ROR21 (below and in Google MyMaps via “Map” QR Code on the right) guides bicyclists along many popular routes in Kalamazoo County. Routes include trails (e.g. Kalamazoo River Valley Trail - KRVT), existing bike routes (e.g. Lovers Lane in Portage and East Main St. in Kalamazoo Township), and proposed bike routes (e.g. 11th St. in Oshtemo Township and Riverview Drive in the City of Parchment and Cooper Township), as well as routes used regularly by the Kalamazoo Bicycle Club (KBC). Come one, come all and Ride Our Routes!



Why? ROR21 offers opportunities for bicyclists of all ages and abilities to be outside riding bicycles and introduces them to our remarkable bicycling infrastructure in the Kalamazoo area.

How? Kalamazoo County road maps and entry forms (see backside of this page) are available at one of our four local bike shops or Gazelle Sports. Ride all ROR21 routes, fill in your entry form, and drop it off at one of the local bike shops or Gazelle Sports. NOTE: Be sure to print your name and email address legibly on the entry form. ROR21 organizers will certify entry forms and send a validation code via email to each participant. Validation codes will allow participants to order and pay \$10.00 for a t-shirt. ROR21 t-shirts will be available in the Fall of 2021.

So... dust off your bike, lube its chain, pump up those tires, get outside, and ride, ride, ride. And remember – wear your helmet. See you riding ROR21 this summer!
